## Why a day of Reflection?

We want to gather African Americans Catholics young and old from across the Diocese to reflect on the findings from the "2011 National Black Catholic Survey". This is the first national survey of its kind to assess the level of religious engagement of African American Catholics. It was prepared by two professors of the University of Notre Dame and sponsored by National Black Catholic Congress. We will pray, reflect and listen to others while we formulate a report on how we can **empower**, **equip** and **evangelize** African American Catholics in our diocese and will also help the National Black Catholic Congress develop a five year Pastoral Plan for African Americans. At the end we hope to prepare those who are going to Congress XI with information and inspiration and also invite others to join us in Indianapolis this summer.
