

Camp Turner – Group Rental Information & Rates

SUMMER WEEKENDS NOW AVAILABLE!

Location

Take exit 18 off I-86. Camp is inside of Allegany State Park, about 8 miles from the I-86, on the left, half way between Quaker Lake and the Quaker store.

Accommodations

The dining hall holds a maximum of 180 persons, and seats a maximum of 150. The cabins sleep a maximum of 120. Two meeting rooms with tables and chairs are also available. All buildings are winterized, insulated and heated to 62 degrees. Beds are twin sized with inner spring mattresses. Mattresses have anti-bacterial coatings. Two campfire rings are available, one in the main circle and one in the woods. 16 park benches are available for outdoor use.

Catering

Camp Turner offers the best catering service in the area, and our prices are the MOST reasonable too! Call for a quote. There is an additional charge of \$300.00 *per meal* if you wish to use outside caterers. Outside caterers may not use pots and pans, utensils, or equipment belonging to Camp Turner.

Dining Hall

The Dining Hall features tables and chairs to seat up to 150. Male and female rest rooms, stocked with paper and hand soap.

Kitchen

Includes: 2 convection ovens, 2 regular ovens, flat top griddle, steam table, reach in refrigerator (2 door) / freezer (2 door), beverage fridge in the dining hall, pots, pans, utensils sufficient to cook for up to 80 people, high speed coffee pot with filters, high speed toaster, regular 4 slice toaster, microwave, can opener, brooms, dust pans, mops buckets, floor cleaner, dish soap for sinks and dishwasher, and disinfectant for tables and counters, toilet paper and trash can liners. Group leader or lead cook must be oriented by camp staff, and follow all required camp procedures for use of equipment and safe handling of food. Additional equipment, plates, silverware for additional fee.

Dish Room

3 bay sink, commercial dishwasher, dish washer racks, dish soap, rinse agent provided. Group leader or lead dish room person must be oriented by camp staff, and follow all required camp procedures for washing, drying and sanitation.

Sleeping cabins

Each cabin is divided into two sides with separate entrances. Each side features a large room with ten beds, and a small bedroom with two beds. Total twelve people per side, twenty four per cabin. Electric heat is set at 62 degrees.

Rosters and Insurance

A roster of participants is required of all groups, and a certificate of insurance is required for all groups except Diocesan parishes, schools and youth groups.

Payments and Deposit Refunds

Payment in full is due upon arrival. Damage deposits will be refunded within three weeks after departure.

Guidelines and Group Orientation

Everyone in your party must agree to the guidelines in the rental agreement to stay at camp. It is the responsibility of the group leader to educate the group to these guidelines and to enforce the guidelines. The entire group must attend a ten minute site orientation upon arrival.

Guest Services: Firewood now available! Ask us about maps and brochures of state park and national forest, park activities, local attractions and lists of local churches. Linens, table cloths, pillows available from and outside vendor. Two weeks notice required.

Weekend (July & August) \$44 / person including lodging plus 5 meals and 2 snacks.

Weekends Sept. - June \$44 / person includes lodging, meeting space, 5 meals and 2 snacks,

Fri. 5 pm to Sun. Noon \$20 per person includes lodging and meeting space.

Weekday Over Nights \$8 per person per night, \$6 per meal, \$2.25 per snack.

Weekdays \$7 per person includes grounds, dining hall and lunch.

Activities right at camp:

Camp Programming Available

Interpretive Nature hikes, groups up to 18 people, \$25 per hour.

Ice Breakers or Team building games, groups up to 18 people, \$25 per hour.

Woodland games, groups up to 18 people, \$25 per hour. May include keeper of the fire, moose deer, coup stick, deer stalk.

Horseback Riding, during summer weekend rentals only, with fundamental safety orientation, 75 minute session, \$10 per person, groups up to 18, minimum 6 people. Smaller groups get more riding time. Those waiting to ride may take turns grooming. Group leader determines group sizes.

Archery, during summer weekend rentals only, with fundamental safety orientation, groups up to 12 people, 75 minutes session, groups up to 18 people. \$5 per person.

Dishwashing is included when we cater for you – we'll wash your dishes if you like. We charge \$2.50 per person per meal. This includes cleaning up the dish room too!

Additional Equipment available for rental:

Your standard rental comes with **80 plates, 80 forks, 80 knives, 80 spoons, 80 plastic cups and 40 coffee mugs**, as well as the cooking equipment listed on the cooking inventory list. Large groups may request additional equipment for additional charge. Use of equipment requires leaving credit card or drivers license with your host.

Cleaning Services

Pre-Arrange for cleaning of your cabins when you book for \$20 per hour. If not pre-arranged, we charge \$30 per hour. Or, clean up yourself and avoid cleaning fees altogether! Supplies are provided to: sweep and mop kitchen, dining hall and shower house, clean toilets and sinks in dining hall and shower house, sweep cabins, take all trash to the dump, pick up all litter, close and lock all windows. Check out with group leader.

Pre-Arranged cleaning service, \$20 per hour.

This is cleaning upon departure only. Does not include ongoing cleaning during the weekend or outside litter pickup. There is a \$50 charge for littering.

Standard Cabin Cleaning, ½ hour per side of a cabin.

Includes: sweeping, taking out trash, adjusting blinds, closing and locking windows.

Does not include (additional charge for): mopping, putting furniture back in original locations, cleaning footprints from mattresses, extraordinary messes.

Standard Kitchen Cleaning, 2 hours.

Includes: Cleaning table tops, counters, stove top and exterior, sinks, mopping, taking out trash, disposal of left items.

Does not include (additional charge for): Washing or putting away of dishes, pots, pans, utensils, cleaning the griddle, oven interior or other appliances.

Standard Dining Hall Cleaning, 2 hours.

Includes: wiping tables, sweeping, mopping around the entrances and dish room window, taking out trash, disposal of left items, cleaning of exit door windows. Cleaning bathroom sinks and toilets, sweeping and moping bathrooms, taking bathroom trash. Does not include (additional charge for): Taking down decorations, returning tables to original locations, stacking chairs in original locations, mopping excessive mud in areas not near the entrances or dish room, cleaning refrigerator, microwave, coffee machine, toasters, coffee pots, extra-ordinary messes.

Standard Shower House Cleaning, 2 hours. Includes: disposal of left items, cleaning sinks, toilets, sweeping and moping floors, taking out trash and equipment buckets. Does not include (additional charge for): extra-ordinary messes (plugged or overflowed toilets, wet toilet paper on floors, walls or ceilings or similar messes).
