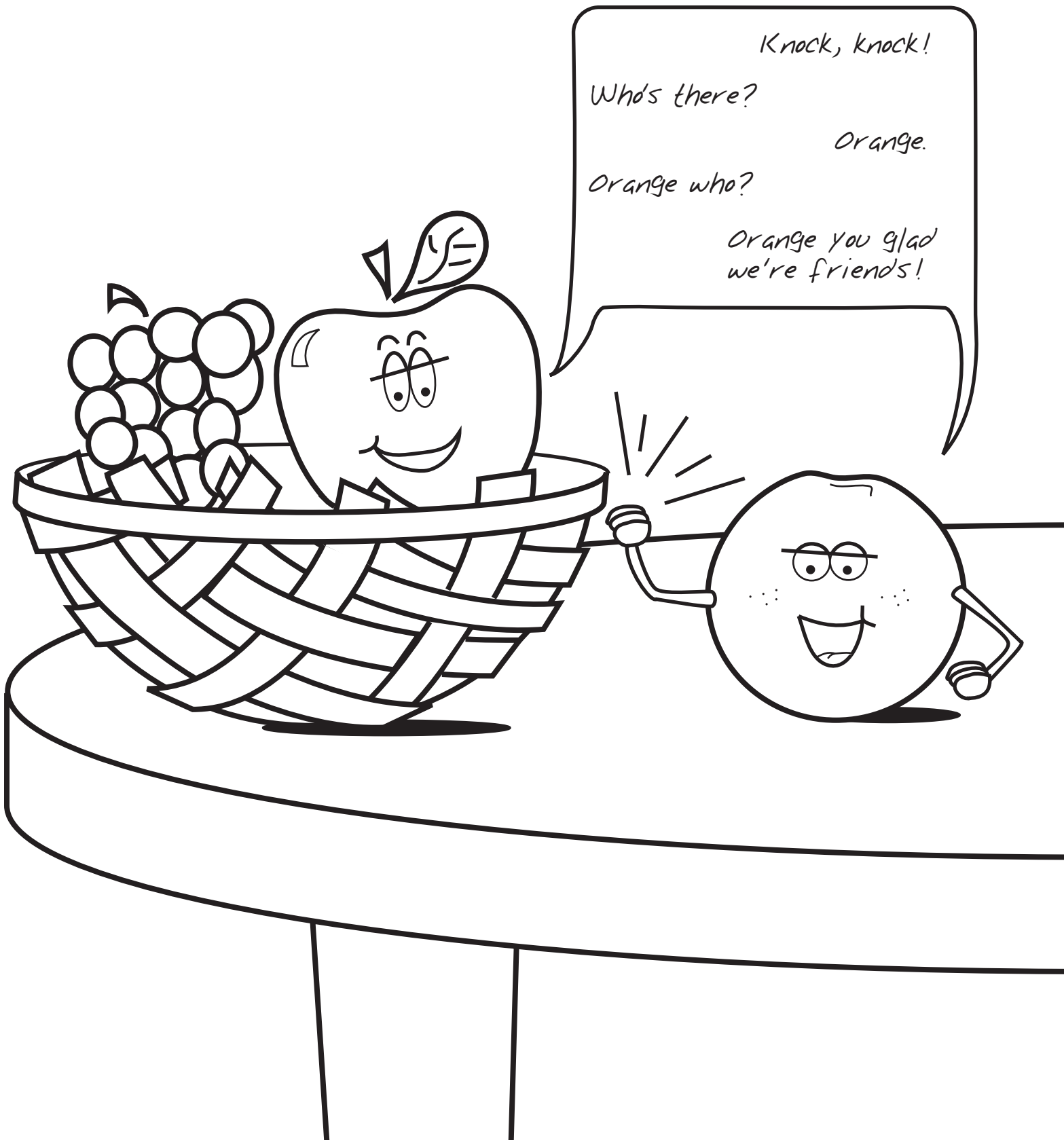


Countin' Mountain...

Connect the dots to make it from the top of the mountain to the bottom of the valley.

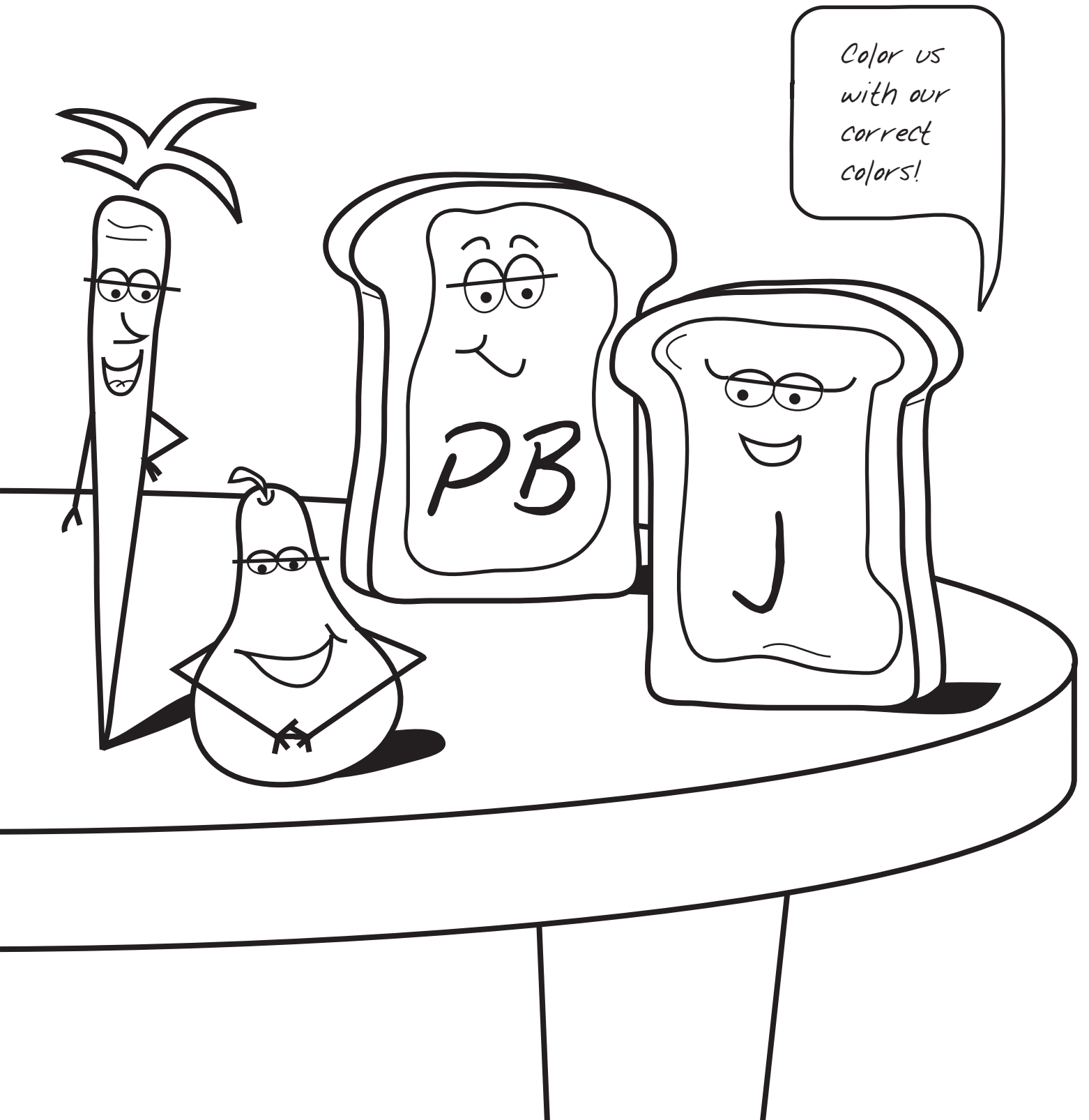
How many rocks do you see? \_\_\_\_\_

Your food is always different, so you like what you eat;

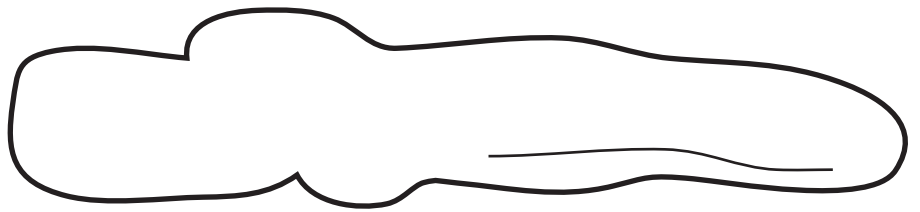


There are apples and oranges,

of a tail!

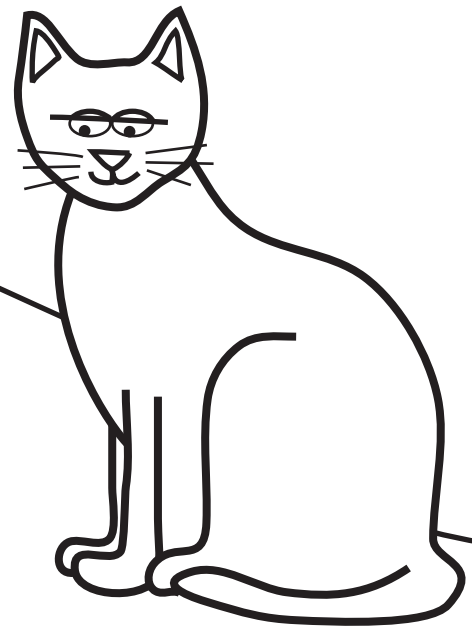
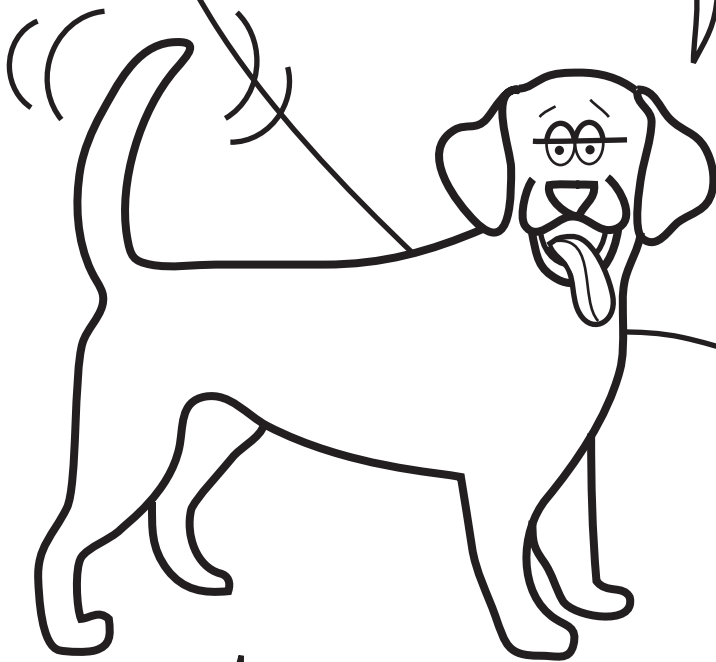


Even animals are different,

for me...ow!

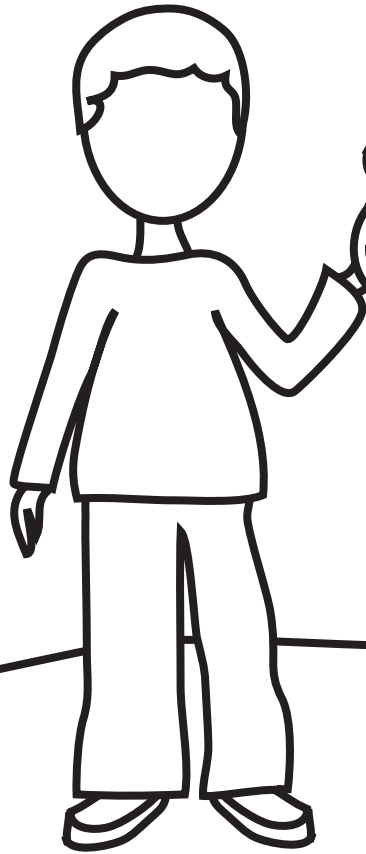


Dogs and cats are different,

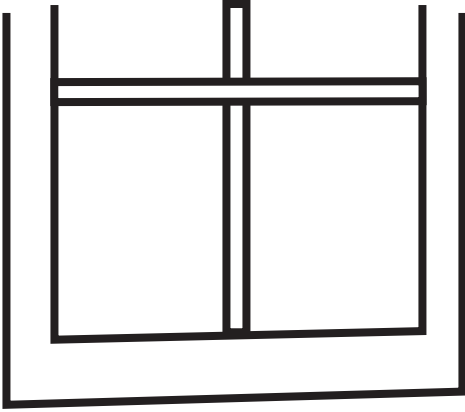

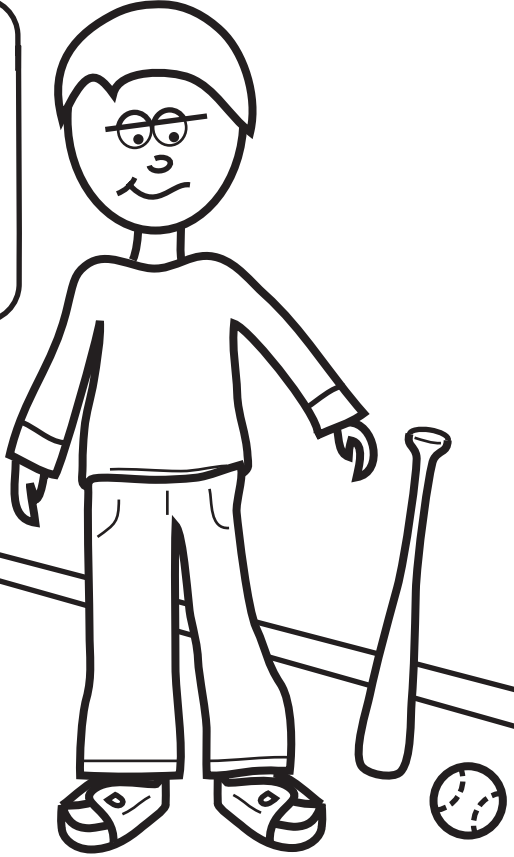
Your parents are different, they are taller than you.

different for Mark, Scott, and Sue.

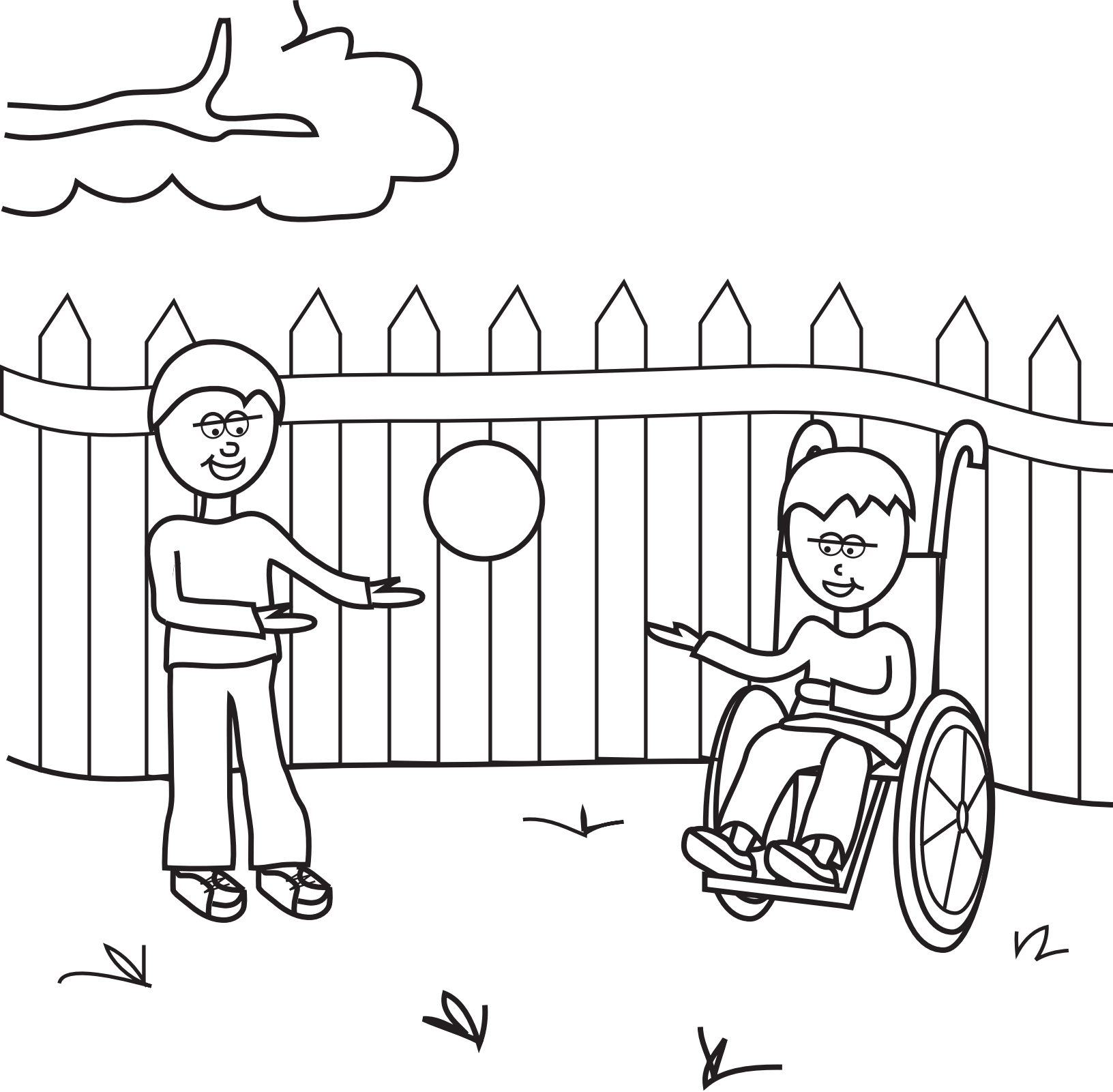


*Color us like your friends and write our names on the lines.*

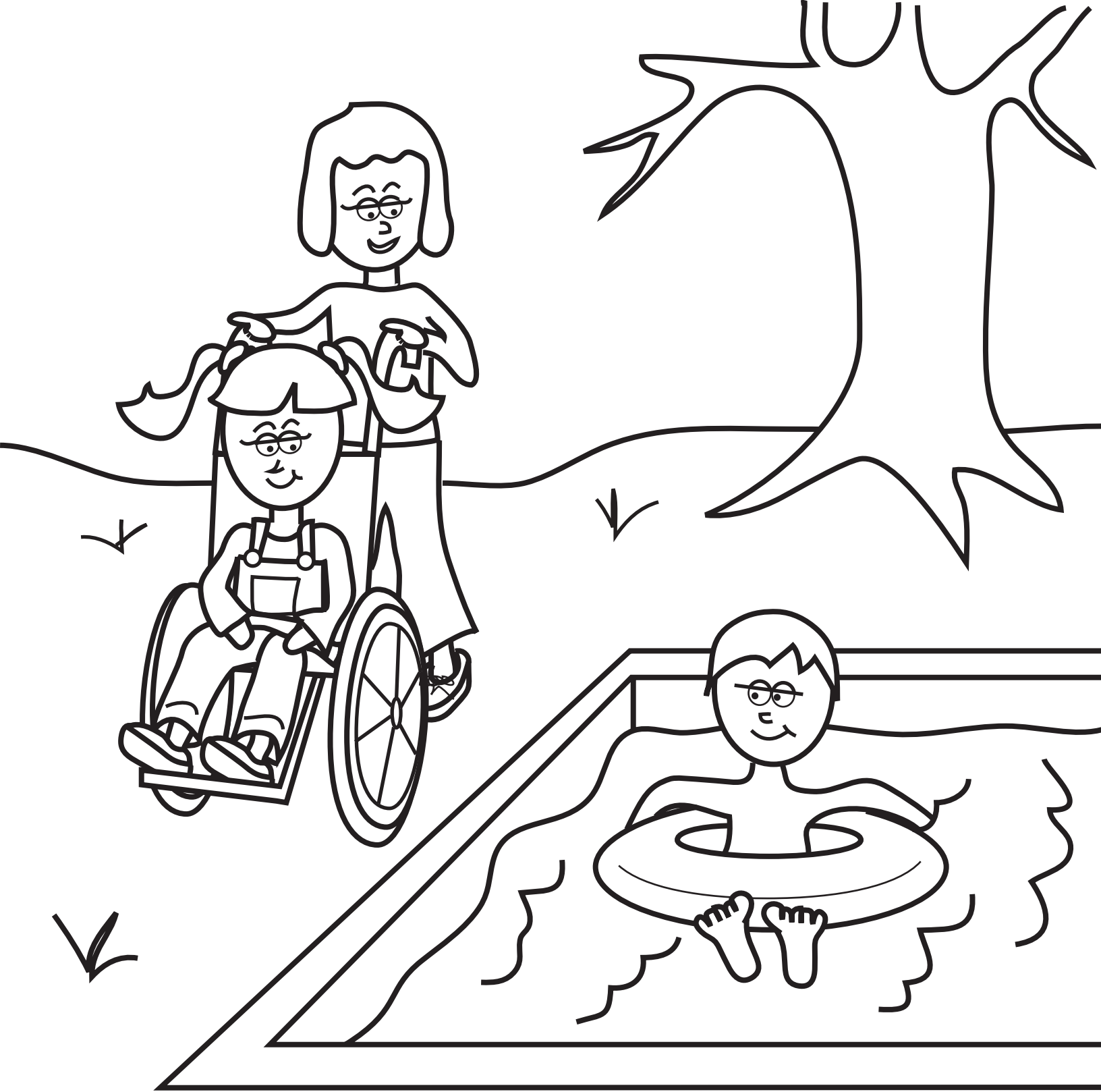


Your friends are all different;

some are girls, some are boys.

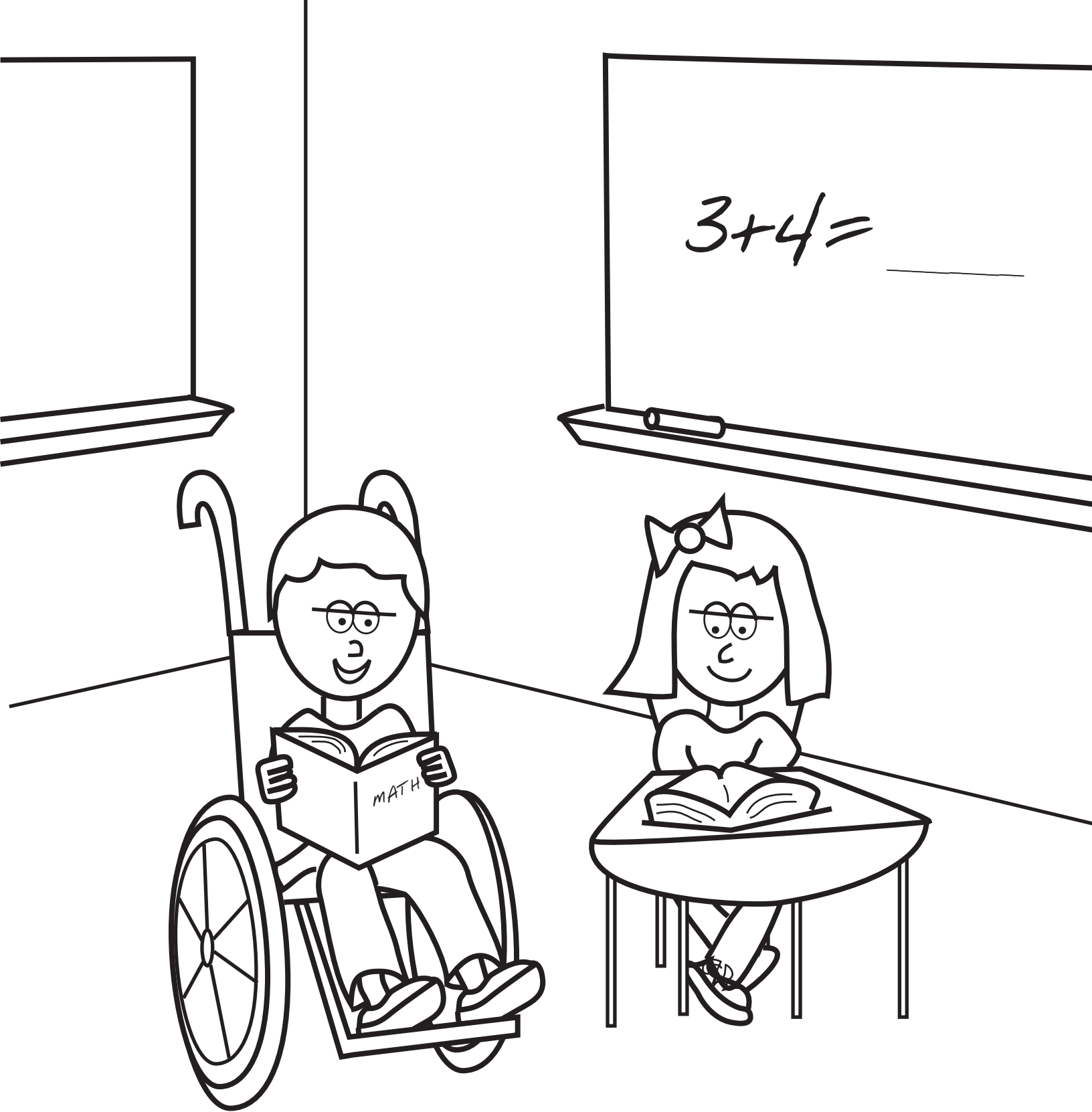




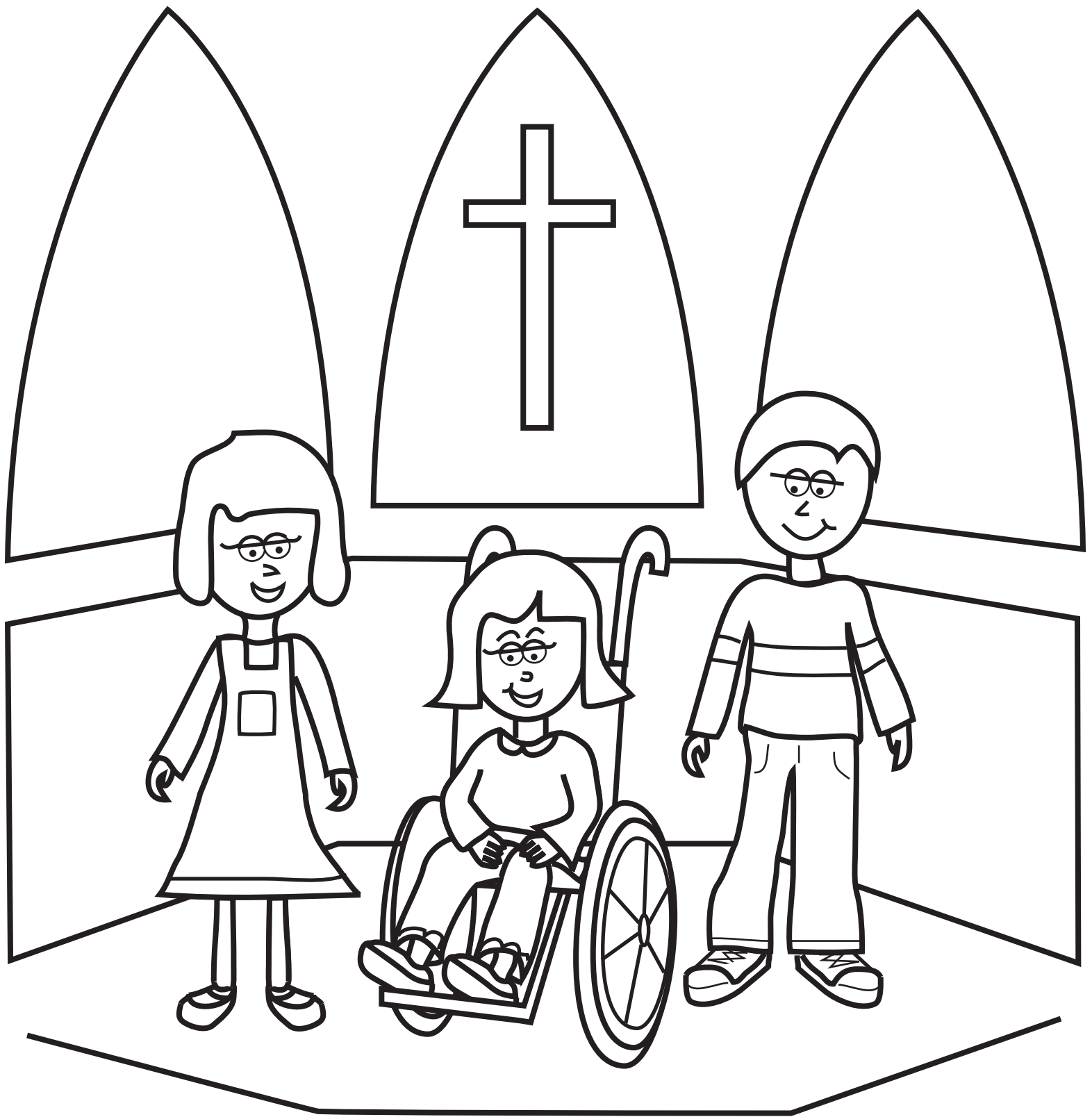
And there are people who are different,
