<b>Announced Masses – offering</b>	\$15.00
<b>Baptism</b>	At the discretion of the parents, Baptismal offerings are made to the celebrant.
<b>Weddings (with or without Mass)</b>	
Church	\$200
Celebrant	\$200
Music Minister	Up to \$175
<b>Funerals (with or without Mass)</b>	
Church	\$150
Celebrant (vigil prayers, Mass & cemetery) <i>Fee to be divided if some rites are led by different ministers. (\$25/\$125/\$25)</i>	\$175
Music Minister	Up to \$150
<b>Weekend Supply Ministry</b> (Saturday afternoon, evening, and Sunday)	
One Mass	\$15 Mass offering plus \$75
Two Masses	\$15 Mass offering for each Mass plus \$125 <sup>^</sup> or \$150 <sup>^^</sup>
<sup>^</sup> (if at same location on same day with no additional travel)	
<sup>^^</sup> (if at different locations, not same day, or additional travel required e.g. 9:30 am Mass & 4:00 pm Mass on the same day and at same location)	
Confessions (for each occasion)	\$30
<b>Weekday Supply Ministry* <sup>^^^</sup></b>	
One Mass	\$15 Mass offering plus \$25 <sup>^^^</sup>
<b>Reconciliation Services <sup>^^^</sup>(for each occasion)</b>	\$50
<sup>^^^</sup> Not applicable to Pastors and Parochial Vicars assigned to the parishes within their Family of Parishes. Note: Mileage is recorded on the priest's business miles log for reimbursement. <b>For all others receiving supply ministry, mileage is not recorded on business mileage logs since the extra clergy payment includes mileage.</b>	
*Vicars (General, Episcopal, Judicial, Forane), Chaplains, and other Priest-in-Residence do not receive weekday supply fees when celebrating Mass the their parish of residence.
